

Parenting Tomorrows Leaders Today: “Healing”

- Memory Verse: “I will put none of these diseases on you....for I Am the Lord who heals you”
Exodus 15:26

Recap:

- We have spent the last month talking about Worship and Healing. We have walked the children through what God says about Healing. We have walked the children through how Jesus healed all who came to Him. We have given the children steps so that they are familiar with how God can heal, but we have also stressed the fact that Jesus did not have a standard way or use a formula to heal.

Talk about it: Block out some time (10-15 Minutes), find a comfortable area of the house, bring out your Bible, and open in prayer. Invite the Holy Spirit to guide the discussion and family time.

- Here are a few scriptures that you and your family can look at and discuss.
 - [Luke 9:5-7](#), [John 5:1-3](#) & [John 9:12-14](#)
- What does it say? What is happening? What does it mean? How does it apply to your family’s life?
- What do these passages say about healing? What are ways you see Jesus healing?

Be about it: (15-20 Minutes) James 1:22 tells us that we are not only to listen to God’s word, we are to do it! Here are some fun and interactive activities that your family can do together. Remember, to become good at anything, it takes a lot of practice. What better thing to practice than the walking in the Supernatural!

- Lead the family by having them picture themselves doing miracles for the Lord...Ask them what they see themselves doing. Then have them close their eyes and pray over them...Pray that The Lord show them miracles of healing and power around them...Have them write it in the pray journal, piece of paper, or note card...Have each person put the date on the prayer card and refer back to that often.
- Practice Praying over each other. Adults, pretend you have an injury and have your child pray over you. See how they do and offer encouragement and coaching. Then change roles and see how you do. This will serve as a confidence builder as well as well needed practice.

Pray about it!

- Close in prayer, thanking the Lord for all He has done and all that He has shown you. Pray that he continues to show your family how all of you can glorify Him.

- Tell others about what happened
- Tell us about what happened
